Terms & Conditions

- 1. We generally only take bookings for a minimum of 7 nights during the summer months and main school holidays, although if the cottage is not booked we will consider a short break. At all other times short breaks are available.
- 2. Bookings made through our online booking system are provisional until confirmed by us.
- 3. A deposit of £100 per week is required to secure the holiday booking. The balance must be paid no later than 30 days before the start of the holiday.
- 4. Bookings made within 30 days of the arrival date must be accompanied by full payment.
- 5. Cancellation policy:
- a. If the booking is cancelled less than 30 days before arrival then a charge equal to 50% of the stay will be made.
- b. If the booking is cancelled less than 7 days before arrival then a charge equal to the full booking amount will be made.
- c. If the booking is cancelled 30 or more days before arrival then a charge equal to the full booking amount will be made.
- 6. Huntsman Cottages reserves the right to cancel or alter the booking arrangements. In the event of cancellation Huntsman Cottages shall only be liable for the return of the monies received.
- 7. The proprietors accept no liability for any accident, injury, loss or damage sustained by any resident, their family, visitors, vehicles or personal effects, however cause.
- 8. The number of people occupying the cottage must not exceed those booked. Huntsman Cottages reserve the right to refuse entry to the entire party if this condition is not observed.
- 9. A maximum of 2 well behaved dogs are welcome by prior arrangement subject to the payment of an additional £20 fee per pet. Please ensure you disclose when making your booking.
- 10. Cottages are available from 4.00pm on the day of arrival and must be vacated by 9.30 am on day of departure.
- 11. On departure the property should be left clean and tidy and in a similar condition as you found it on arrival. Accidental damage or breakages of a minor nature will not normally be charged but the occupier will be liable for any damage over £10.
